

Understanding Your Identity in Christ

The central theme of the Christian Life rests on two intersecting axes of one's **Identity in Christ**. The first is your "**Confidence**" in Christ's sufficiency to save you apart from your own self-efforts, and the second is the "**Control**" you allow Him to have over your daily life. These two factors determine whether your Christian Life is lived in victory or defeat, arrogance, and resentment.

Instructions:

Answer each of the following 20 questions by marking them as either "Mostly True" or "Mostly Untrue." Base your answer on your *initial* response rather than what you think the correct answer *should* be. Being honest rather than "correct" will best help.
